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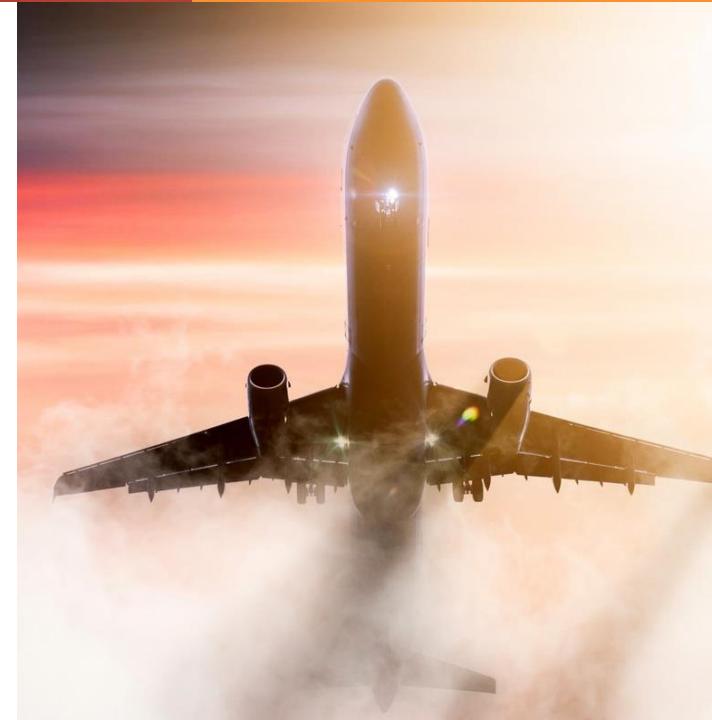
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CONTEXT

Aviation training programmes

A set of initial and continuing Aeronautics VET training programmes will be developed for skills upgrade and career development of pilots, air traffic controllers, ground handling operators and RPAS operators.
